
Registered Unemployment in the Silesian Voivodeship at the end of December 2024

The number of unemployed registered in local labor offices at the end of December 2024 amounted to 62 583 people and was higher than the one observed at the end of the 3th quarter of 2024 by 154 people.

Women predominate in the population of the unemployed in the Silesian Voivodeship. At the end of December 2024 women accounted for 52.2% of the total number registered unemployed in the local labor offices (3^{th} quarter 2024 – 53.3%).

The unemployed possessing benefit rights comprised 15.6% of all registered (9 789 people). Compared to the third quarter of 2024, the number of unemployed with benefit rights increased by 336 people.


As at the end of December 2024, there were 47 497 people in the registers that are qualified by the act on Promotion of employment and institutions of the labor market to be in a specific situation on the labor market.

As of 31th December 2024, the unemployment rate in Silesia was 3.6% (country 5.1%). Our voivodship is on the second place on the list of voivodships with the lowest indicator value, just after Wielkopolska (3.0%).

In the fourth quarter of 2024 there were 29 644 people registered at the poviat labor offices of the Silesian Voivodeship (so called "inflow"), of which 49.1% were women. Compared to the 3th quarter of 2024, the number of unemployed who registered in the reporting quarter decreased by 1 844 people.

In the fourth quarter of 2024 there were recorded 29 490 who removed from the unemployment rolls (so called "outflow") which means a decrease by 1 180 people in relation to the previous quarter (the third quarter 2024 – 30 670). Largest group of "outflow" represented those who took up a job.

At the end of December 2024, unemployed mostly use the following active forms of counteracting the unemployment: internships, intervention works and public works.

In December 2024 in the registers of powiat labor offices of the Silesian Voivodeship there were 2 531 jobseekers. Men predominated among the jobseekers (1 453 people – 57.4%).

In the fourth quarter of 2024 a total number of 20 560 information on job vacancies and places of professional activation were submitted to labor offices in powiats, 93.3% of which were non-subsidized job offers. At the end of the quarter there were 4 729 job vacancies and places for professional activation at the disposal for the unemployed and jobseekers.

In the fourth quarter of 2024 employers declared their intention to lay off 1 944 employees, at the same time 934 people lost their jobs as a result of the group layoffs. At the end of the reporting quarter, the number of people at risk of collective redundancies in the entire voivodship amounted to 3 296 people.
